Dementia Capable Care – Foundation Course

Course Description

- The course is 8 hours in length.
- A certification is issued at the end of the course provided the participant meets requirements of the class. This certification is valid for one year.
- Course hours can be set up as it best works between the organization(s) and the instructor availability and can be delivered in 4-hour blocks over two days as an alternative to one 8-hour day.
- This course is conducted at your location.
- This course meets the requirements set forth by the MN State Legislature requiring direct care givers to receive 8-hours of initial Dementia training.
- This course is approved by the Alzheimer’s Organization (alz.org).

Requirements

- A minimum of 18 participants/class will be required.
- Books and training materials will be provided for all participants, which they may keep.
- Full attendance, class participation and successful completion of the post-test are necessary for certification.
- Participants will be given a workbook to write in during the course. A classroom that can accommodate this set-up is preferred.

Payment

- The cost per participant under the grant is 50% of the normal course fee.
- Advanced Minnesota will invoice each organization for their portion of the fee.
